The Project

SPICE Seismic wave **P**ropagation and **I**maging in **C**omplex media: a **E**uropean network

SPICE is a Marie Curie Research Training Network in the 6th Framework Program of the European Commission. Its focus is research and training in all aspects of **computational seismology**. The 4-year project started on **January 1, 2004**.

The SPICE network is comprised of 14 partner institutes throughout Europe each having a postdoc and Ph.D. position. Most positions were filled mid 2004, however there are still a few vacancies in the network. See the Opportunities section for further details.
